The Sequoia tree is among the world's largest and most enduring redwoods. It can grow to 300 feet high, weigh over 2.5 million pounds and live for 3,000 years. The majestic sequoia owes much of its size and longevity to what lies below the surface. A twelve to fourteen-foot-deep matting of roots, spreading over as much as an acre of earth, firmly grounds its towering height and astonishing weight.
