Remember you will always be instructed as to what to do, so please follow Safety Signs! Thank you! Harleigh (your Nurses Assistant) has been working on a project to update your post forms that hang in your rooms for emergency care needs if necessary. They are now color coded. Post form stands for Physician Orders for Scope of Treatment. Those who have a "Resuscitate/CPR" order will have a green form and green circle on it. Those with a "DNR/Do Not Resuscitate" order will have a red form and red circle and these will be posted on the closet door next to the front door. Having these placed in the same location will help tremendously in an emergency situation. Please DO NOT remove or move them. These forms will let the staff and outside emergency personnel know your wishes. The color coding system has also been placed in your Care plans, to help assist your needs quicker if a situation arises. Thank you to All Residents in complying with this new change! We continue to strive to make your home a safer place to live. Chad your Maintenance manager wants all to know the water heater is up and running Great! I've heard that showers are again being enjoyed and Thanks for your patience.
